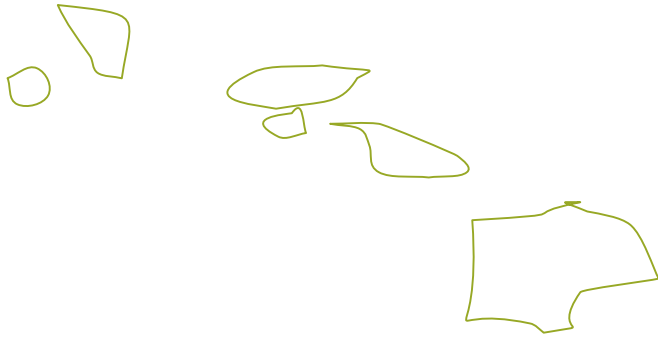


# Hawaii

## Hawaii Department of Human Services State-Administered Structure



There are no written policies, but data are collected on young women and men who are parenting; the number and custodial status of children of young women in foster care; and the race/ethnicity, length of stay and permanency status of parenting youth in foster care.

The state of Hawaii provides extended foster care to age 21 under Title IV-E.
