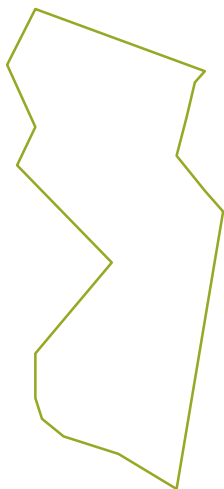


# New Jersey



There are written policies to identify and serve expectant and parenting youth in foster care who are under 18 years old.

There are policies that include male and female youth 18 years old and older who are parenting within the overall scope of policy, but no standalone policies specific to males and females who are expectant or parenting at 18 or older.

The state of New Jersey does not provide extended foster care under Title IV-E.
