There are written policies to identify expectant and parenting mothers and fathers in foster care who are 21 years old and younger.

Data are collected on the number and custodial status of children of young women in foster care, as well as the race and ethnicity, length of stay and permanency status of parenting youth in foster care.

The state of Rhode Island provides extended foster care under Title IV-E.
