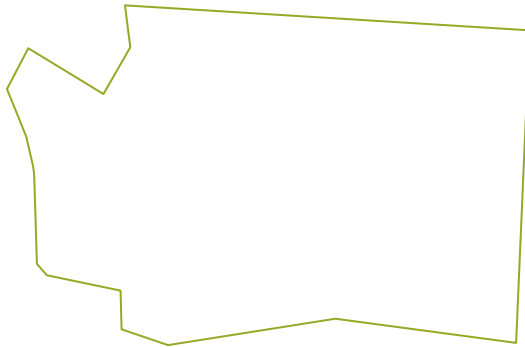


Washington
