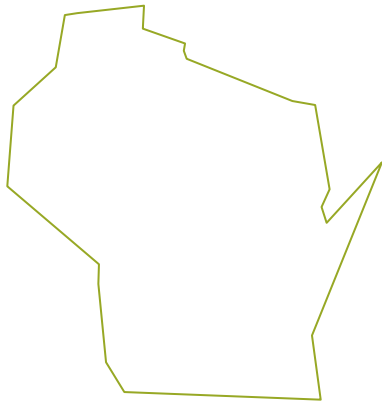


Wisconsin

Data are collected on the race and ethnicity, length of stay and permanency status of parenting youth in foster care.

The state of Wisconsin provides extended foster care to age 21 under Title IV-E.
