

Performance Measures for Deep End Site Support Grants

Below are the Standard Performance Measures for Deep End sites. All data should be disaggregated by race, ethnicity, and gender. The tracking sheet in the [Deep End Tool Kit](#) has been designed to help organize data, easily calculate changes and ratios, identify gaps, and run some initial validation checks.

Measure 1	# of referrals
Measure 1a	# of referrals diverted from formal processing
Measure 2	# of dispositions to probation
Measure 2a	# of dispositions to probation where most recent risk assessment prior to disposition was low risk
Measure 3	# commitments to state custody
Measure 4	# total out-of-home placements (including commitments to state custody)
Measure 4a	# of out-of-home placements where most recent risk assessment prior to placement was low risk
Measure 4b	# of out-of-home placements where most recent risk assessment prior to placement was moderate risk
Measure 4c	# of out-of-home placements where most recent risk assessment prior to placement was high risk
Measure 4d	# of out-of-home placements arising from technical violations of probation
Measure 5	# of felony filings
Measure 6	# of youth tried as adults (via transfer, direct file, bindover, certification, waiver, etc.)
Measure 7	average daily population (ADP) in detention
Measure 8	ratio of overall out-of-home placements relative to felony filings within the year
Measure 9	# of detention admissions (or ADP, if that is easier to report) due to contempt, program failures, or technical violations

Once a dispositional matrix or probation recommendation grid has been adopted, sites should also track:

- # of total dispositions in each cell of the jurisdiction's dispositional matrix;
- # of dispositions to probation in each cell of the jurisdiction's dispositional matrix; and
- # of dispositions to out-of-home placement in each cell of the jurisdiction's dispositional matrix.
