The Future Foundation is a nonprofit organization that provides two-generation services to interrupt generational poverty. Through our Second Family afterschool model, we serve students in grades 6–12 and their families, empowering them to address the needs they see in their communities.

We work with youth to elevate their voice, support their academic success, and reinforce the skills they need to thrive in adulthood. We actively invite families to shape how Future Foundation serves students and we coordinate with local community organizations to deliver services. In this way, we build a foundation for a better future for us all.

## **Future Foundation Is Evaluation Ready**

The Annie E. Casey Foundation invested in Future Foundation as a Building Evidence to Advance Equity grantee to build evaluation capacity.

Being evaluation ready means a program has the knowledge, skills, and practices to test the effectiveness of its services. Future Foundation has a solid foundation for evaluation based on its program logic model and fidelity tools to measure performance, and it is prepared for responsible and data-driven growth. The voices of students and families are at the center of Future Foundation's decision-making and guide all evaluation and programmatic planning.



Since the Future Foundation was founded in 2001, we have impacted over 30,000 students and families. Our most recent accomplishments include—

Graduating students with gifts for college



**100% high school graduation rate** for students (compared to 80.6% for nonparticipants)<sup>1</sup>



Over half of students improved their math and English language arts grades<sup>2</sup>



Over 2/3 of students reported improved social and emotional wellness and decreased risky behaviors<sup>2</sup>



Almost all parents reported improved communication with their children about academics (80%) and risky behaviors (90%)<sup>2</sup>
