The Emergent Learning Table creates a structure for learning conversations that helps a group explore the knowledge they already have and synthesize the knowledge they are creating through their collective advocacy and action. Emergent Learning helps refine the collective thinking process and make deliberate connections between past data and insights as well as forward-thinking hypotheses and opportunities.
